

2023 South Munster Schools Track & Field Championships

Final Information (for Athletes and Teachers)

- 1 Registration located near the red brick pavilion. Here individual athletes and preferably the teacher/school representative will collect their numbers. Individual athletes can also collect their numbers and pay the €3 entry fee if the school has indicated that it's athletes are to pay themselves.
- 2 Athletes competing on more than one day should wear the same number on the second day without the need to go to registration again.

- 4 In track events, **athletes will need to check in at their event start line 15 minutes before their race.** Late arrivals at the start line will not be accommodated if this is going to cause a delay to the start of the race.
- 5 The track will be in use for club training up to 12 noon. All South Munster personnel must remain outside the track fence until we are allowed access.
- 6 On May 6th all minor girls and minor boys 100m competitors are to assemble near but not on the GAA pitch at 11:45am on the eastern side of the track. Likewise inter girls and inter boys 100m competitors should assemble at the concrete spectator terracing near the 100m start line on the river side of the track. These athletes will be assigned a heat and lane draw before they enter the track.
- 7 With the exception of the 100m all other track medallists will be determined by times where heats are required.
- 8 The Rugby and GAA pitches along with the All Weather pitch in the infield are all out of bounds to our athletes. Warm can be done on any used section of the track as appropriate. Generally the Arena side of the track and/or the bend near the car park should be OK for warming up
- 9 **No parking facilities will be available in the stadium.** Parking is reserved for Mardyke Arena members only. Pay or disk parking should be available at the Sacred Heart church across the road and along the Mardyke Walk.
- 10 On Saturday 6th few extra officials will be needed at the very start of the meeting in order to run off the 100msprints at either side of the track. This will involve assembling athletes at the start line and recording the result at the finish line.
